By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 in 2004 other than restricted stake allowed 2 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 6, 2004 with 26 Nominations.

BALDOMERA was outrun along the inside early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. WHIRLWIND CHARLOTT raced close up outside, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and tired in the drive. FREEROLL had no response when roused. SHE'S A MUGS set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
