FATAL CAPER unhurried off the rail early, moved up outside under urging on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under steady handling. MY HONEY BUNNY stalked outside a rival, bid outside the pacesetter and took a short lead into the stretch, battled between foes in midstretch, could not match the winner but clearly bested the others. SUSIE JOE'S stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. WEST COAST GEE GEE sped to the early lead three deep, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FUNNY BONE chased off the rail then inside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. MUSICAL REVIEW washy and fractious in the post parade, settled off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and failed to menace.
