HOLLYWOOD STORY chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn, bid three deep then shifted inward entering the stretch, collared the runner-up inside the eighth pole and pulled clear under left handed urging. RAHY DOLLY had good early speed three deep, inched away and angled to the inside leaving the first turn, responded when rivals bid on the backstretch, kicked clear again on the second turn, could not hold off the winner but was clearly second best. HOUSE OF FORTUNE pulled her way between horses early then stalked outside a rival, bid between foes on the backstretch, continued between rivals on the second turn, steadied in tight behind the winner into the stretch and saved the show. VICTORY U. S. A. close up stalking the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and weakened. RINGS AND THINGS chased outside, moved up boldly four wide on the backstretch, dropped back into the second turn, angled in some leaving that turn and gave way. DIXIE HIGH chased off the rail, split horses three deep with a quick move forward on the backstretch, fell back into the second turn, drifted out some and had nothing left. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run into the stretch but made no change when they ruled the trouble to HOUSE OF FORTUNE did not affect the original order of finish.
