TEE PHONE HOME raced wide into the first turn, rushed bid going to the half, led on the turn and was challenged near the 3/8 pole from KWAME to his outside, put that rival away entering the stretch, angled to the rail in upper stretch and was put to an all out drive to prevail in last strides. KWAME broke outward from the gate, was rated early, moved widest going down the backstretch, dueled outside of TEE PHONE HOME on the turn, fell back in upper stretch, surged late at the finish to just miss in a very game effort. BAMA ROYAL hustled from the gate, held a small lead going into the first turn racing well off the rail, was taken back to stalk going to the half, asked for more mid turn, rallied while between foes at the 1/4 pole, leveled off midstretch. CASTLE HILL hustled and pressed early, angled inside far turn, loomed near the 1/4 pole while under a drive, failed to keep pace in upper stretch and weakened at the 1/8 pole. SAINTED COLONY hustled and vied for the lead early along the inside, dropped off after a half, chased on the turn and drifted wide entering the stretch, no factor from there. SAINTLY CORP. was quickly outrun and raced very wide throughout.
